**DATE OF COMMENCEMENT OF LIABILITY UNDER
SECTION 11.1 OF THE TRADING AND SETTLEMENT
CODE**

Introduction

This document contains a decision by the Commission for Electricity Regulation under Section 11.1(C) of the Trading and Settlement Code [“the Code”].

Commission’s Decision

The Commission hereby determines that the date after which the Settlement Administrator [“the SSA”], the Meter Registration System Operator [“the MRSO”], the Transmission System Operator [“the TSO”] and the Distribution System Operator [“DSO”] shall be liable for any loss or damage arising out of negligence or wilful neglect in connection with the Electricity Trading and Settlement Rules [“the Rules”] or errors in metered as set out under Section 11.1 (C) of the Code shall be revised and extended to the 31st March 2002 or until such date as the Commission issues a decision on the issue of liability under the Code.

Background

The Commission has decided that the date for liability will be extended on the basis that the consultation period extends beyond the current date for the commencement of liability. In addition, the Commission wishes to have sufficient time to consider in detail all responses and submissions made to it on this subject before making a decision regarding the appropriate enduring solution to be put in place for all market operators.
