

Dear Sean,

Viridian Power and Energy support the CER proposals for introduction of a green VIPP. We prefer that the GVIPP is available in contracts that are as long as possible, but do note that if it continues on into the SEM that some further clarification on the rules may be necessary.

We suggest as an addition to the proposals set out in your consultation paper that a methodology should be created that will give preference to suppliers purchasing GVIPP to provide competition to the domestic sector. This could be facilitated by providing first preference to suppliers purchasing GVIPP for supply to the domestic sector through a combination of priority volume and lower prices (clearing price?). We would welcome further discussions with you on this issue.
