We have become aware of your consultation document on the matter of Net Metering.

Our company is currently working to secure planning permission for Ireland's first "passive" housing development of 21 housing units in North County Dublin – i.e. building houses that produce all their heat and hot water from renewables, passive gain and by significantly increasing insulation.
