**Definition for the Scope of Gas Works – Draft Decision Paper**

Dear Dermot,

Bord Gáis Networks welcomes the publication of the Commissions *draft decision paper on Regulation of Gas Installers with respect to safety, definition for the scope of gas works*. We are supportive of the draft decisions as set out in the paper.

We would propose two additional points;

1. That consideration be given to including a specific exclusion from the scope of gas works, of works on installations associated with the supply of gas for automotive use and works on gas fuelled automotive vehicles.
2. In relation to the voluntary register for installers carrying out commercial gas works we would propose that consideration be given to including an objective 'assessment' of the fitter's competence as part of the registration criteria. This could be reviewed in the context of the Commissions views on the appropriateness or otherwise of the publication of all or part of the voluntary register.

We look forward to the publication of the Commissions final decision paper and we will continue to support the full implementation of the new regulatory regime.
