

#### **Context**

Government target - 40% of electricity from renewables in 2020;

Gate 3 process is critical in meeting this target





#### **IWEA Members in Gate 3**

#### IWEA represent members with interests:

- In approx 73% of Gate 3 projects
- With approx 86% of the total Renewables MW in Gate 3
- Investing approx €5.7 Billion



#### **Objectives**

- Timely Delivery of Quality Connection Offers that can be Executed to allow Delivery of Projects
- 2. Innovation in Connection Offer Creation and Project Delivery
- 3. To have all policies in place for Connection Offers and Delivery



#### **Context for Gate 3 Liaison Group**

- The CER Gate 3 Direction note that the Gate 3 Liaison Group Meeting will:
  - provide a forum to communicate and discuss ongoing Gate 3 issues of interest to the industry, for example on the form of Gate 3 constraints information, and
  - it will also work to ensure that the Gate 3 offer programme is being adhered to.
- The current Terms of Reference agreed in February 2009 note the Group will discuss and facilitate the progress of the Gate 3 offer programme and help ensure that the key milestones are being adhered to



### **Terms of Reference Proposal**

- Currently the offer programme is deemed to be the issuing of offers by the SO's
- IWEA would again consider that Gate 3 needs to issue <u>Quality</u>
   Connection Offers that can be Executed to allow Delivery of Projects
- While issuing of offers is a valid milestone to monitor, offer execution is also a key milestone requiring monitoring. - offer execution is the accepting or rejecting of offers and project delivery
- For post offer issues there is a requirement of timescales and milestones and these should be reported through the Gate 3 Liaison Group
- IWEA would like this recognised in the Terms of Reference



## **Terms of Reference Proposal - 2**

- It is also noted that the Gate 3 Liaison Group also discusses ongoing Gate 3 issues of interest to the industry as intended by the CER Gate 3 direction and as such has organically moved into discussing post offer issues e.g. Modifications, Temporary connections etc.
- IWEA would also like this recognised in the Terms of Reference
