



## **Endesa Ireland response to SEM-11-079 – Global Settlement – The Residual Meter Volume Interval Proportion**

Endesa Ireland agrees with the proposal to initially allocate Residual Volume to non-interval metered demand. It is submitted that this RMVIP should be reviewed when data for a full year has been collected and a decision should be made at that time on the frequency of subsequent reviews.

Endesa Ireland highlights the importance of the reduction of losses and the responsibility of the DSO to achieve this reduction. The DSO should now improve its methodology for recording the measurement of losses in order that the losses incentive scheme decided on in CER/10/198 can be implemented in full. It is also noted that Smart Metering technology offers the possibility to measure and attribute losses more accurately. In this context, Endesa Ireland looks forward to the publication by CER later in the Summer of a consultation paper on high level design and implementation of Smart Metering, as signalled in CER/11/080.
