## Draft Comments on Consultation Paper on a Levy Methodology for Licensed LPG Undertakings CER/14/045

**Q1.** The CER requests respondent's views on which criteria should be used to calculate an undertaking's proportion of the levy payable.

**Reply :** From a competition prospective there can be no question of Calor providing any information on the number of Calor metered sites and metered customers to anyone, in any way that could be interrupted as sharing information on market share.

To avoid the issue of sharing confidential information the cost of the levy should be divided equally by the number of licences .

**Q2. The CER requests respondent's views on the proposed ongoing operation of the annual levy**

**Reply :** The levy for 2014 is €86,200 can we take it that the levy for 2015,2016.....etc. will be reduced taking into account in future there will be no set up costs included . Can the CER provide any indication of future levy's.

To avoid the issue of sharing confidential information the cost of the levy should be divided equally by the number of licences .
