I refer to the above address and wish to point out that since we began living at this property we have had to install a salt water filter @ an approximate cost of €1,000. We have to buy salt for this filter on a regular basis for the past nine years and will have to continue to do same in the future to protect all our appliances and pipes, as the water in our area of belgooly is extremely hard, we were advised to do so by an expert in this field when we moved into our home initially. We subsequently had to install an osmosis system as we had children and the water from the water filter that was protecting our household appliances was not suitable to give to babies as it was too high in salt. We have to get both systems services annually at a high cost.

In this regard I wish to receive a waiver in respect of the forthcoming water charges as we are already paying a high cost for the past nine years to have a good supply go water as this is not supplied to us.

I can supply if needed letters from water service company and receipts where possible if needed.
