I refer to the proposed charges to be introduced for the use of water. I would point out that if consumers are supplied with water that is unfit for human consumption, or are in an area where hard water is a major issue, I feel that all levies should be waived until such time as the water supply has been treated and brought up to a standard fit for consumption directly from the tap.

Consumers are, in most cases been hit twice for water charges having to buy bottled water while boil water notices are in place for contaminated water while in other areas, hard water is causing financial strain on families whose household appliances have to be replaced on a regular basis.

It is unacceptable that water, unfit for human consumption, is allowed to enter the food chain without any penalty in the first place, never mind people having to pay for it!

Safe, consumable water is a must before charges are introduced in any form.
