Subject: Submissions for Irish Waters Water Charges Plan

Dear Sir/Madam,

I would like to make a submission on the Irish Water '*Water Charges Plan*'.

1. Introduction of Charges

Water is already paid for through general taxation so there should not be any double taxation using a vital natural resource as an excuse.

7. Household Allowances- all households will receive an annual household allowance of 30,000 litres for water and wastewater services.

The Government will pay for 30,000 litres per year? Awfully kind of them considering where they get their funding from- the people!

8. Medical Conditions-customers with medical conditions which require increased water consumption will be capped at the assessed charge for that household even if they have a meter.

People with medical conditions should have no charges whatsoever.

9. Water quality- where water is unfit for human consumption, affected customers will receive a 50% discount on the costs of their water supply for the duration of the restriction.

There should be zero charge if the water is unfit for use. Sale of Goods and Supply of Services Act 1980 should cover that.
