Hello.

I am concerned about the lack of information regarding the imminent request expected from Irish Water asking for my details and also regarding the costs and charges associated with the new water company that i will be billed for. I will be seeking advice on the legality of giving my PPS number to a utility service as i do not supply this to any other service that i pay for.

I also would like to ask if you could provide anymore information regarding my following concerns related with Irish Water and its set up:

As a semi-state company what does this mean for the future of the public's water supply?

Is Irish Water intending to make profit from the supply of water?

The County Councils water departments have been running our water supply for as long as i know, what will now happen to the employees of those water departments now that Irish Water will be running the supply and maintenance?

What will Irish Water be doing that the County Councils weren't doing?

Is there any other changes going to be made apart from metering the water supply?

I would also like to express my disgust at the fact that Dennis O'Brien's company Siteserv received the contract for the water metering considering his dubious history with the state and despite the fact that the tax payer has had to cover his bad debts through N.A.M.A.

I am not happy about the excessive salaries and bonuses that some Irish Water employees are receiving and about the obscene consultant fees during the set up as ultimately it will be the taxpayer who foots the bill for this.

I would appreciate an honest reply.
