To whom it may concern,

It is my understanding that it is up to CER to decide on whether fluoridated water is safe for drinking. In light of all the research and that Ireland are one of the few countries world wide with a mandatory fluoridation policy this needs to be re-examined as a matter of urgency.

My family does not drink or cook with, any publicly supplied water in Ireland. I know of many families doing the same. Does anyone at your company who is informed and aware of the research drink publicly supplied water?

I recommend that a households expense to obtain water which is safe to drink & cook with should be deducted from the water tariff in order to calculate the adjusted fee.
