Irish Water charges proposals

It is beyond belief that Irish Water is not going to provide allowances to individuals rather than a building. I have three second level children all living at home and they have an allowance of 6,000 ltrs of water per year. My neighbour has 30,000 free ltrs per year. How is this even constitutional? People are not being given equal treatment. I face an annual bill of €584 - a long way from the supposed average bill (which seems to change often anyway). I fully accept that water should be charged for but it should be on a fair basis. How is it fair that my kids get only 6,000 free ltrs of water per year? This is totally anti family!

It also seems that Irish Water now want to base the allowance on a quarterly basis so the measly allowance could be affected by reduced usage during certain quarters! This is madness!
