



Electricity Regulation Act 1999 (LPG Safety Licence) Levy Order 2016

SI 283 of 2016

The Electricity Regulation Act 1999 (LPG Safety Licence) Levy Order 2016 (SI 283 of 2016) was signed on 30 May 2016 and commenced on 31 May 2016. The levy is imposed upon licensed LPG undertakings for the purpose of meeting expenses properly incurred by the CER in the discharge of its functions under the *Electricity Regulation Act 1999*, as amended *inter alia* by the *Energy (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2012*.

In calculating the levy amount required, the CER takes into account internal costs, such as resources, staff time spent on LPG regulatory activities, technical and legal costs.

The levy amount may change from year to year and is calculated at the end of each year for the coming year based on the CER Energy Safety Division's anticipated work plan.

This is in line with the LPG Levy Methodology, as published on 30 April 2014, following a public consultation (CER/14/101).
