**NOTICE TO HOLDERS OF GENERATION LICENCES AND SUPPLY LICENCES GRANTED UNDER SECTION 14(1) (a), 14(1) (b) AND 14(1) (h) OF THE ELECTRICITY REGULATION ACT, 1999**

The CRU has been notified that a request for the establishment of an Appeal Panel pursuant to Section 29 of the Electricity Regulation Act, 1999 (the Act) has been received by the Minister's Office in the Department of Communications, Climate Action and Environment (DCCAIE).

The request relates to the Decision of the Commission for Regulation of Utilities, formerly known as the Commission for Energy Regulation (CRU) on modifications to Generation Licences and Supply Licences, which issued on 15 September 2017 (CER/17/277) and were due to take effect no later than 16 October 2017.

In light of this notification, and according to Section 22(4) of the Act, the CRU decision CER/17/277 dated 15 September 2017, together with the licence modifications set out therein, have been suspended pending the decision of the Appeal Panel.

DCCAIE has confirmed that an Appeal Panel will be established in accordance with Section 29(3) of the Act. Section 29(8) of the Act requires that the appeal shall be determined within six months of the establishment of the panel.

Alongside this Notice we publish the version of Generation Licences and Supply Licences, as they currently stand.
