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Good evening John

I contacted the minister several months ago with respect to the EU Directive requiring electricity suppliers to buy back, within reasonable limits, electricity exported to the grid by their customers.

Unfortunately I only got a response today along with a link to your document CRU21117CRU, a couple of days to late to respond through the appropriate channels.

However could I make one comment with respect to those customers who do not have a smart meter. Instead of using your proposed estimated export based upon the size of the customers installation could you utilise the export values available from the inverter/battery manufacturers software. I have a Sonnen battery which through the SonnenApp provides me with values for, Grid Purchased, Grid Exported and Electricity Consumed amongst others. The accuracy of these figures could be established by comparing the Apps Grid Purchase with that recorded by ESNB and then factoring the export value accordingly for a sample of the nations customers utilising different manufacturers.

I'd be more than willing to compare my supplier billed values to those provided by the App.
